

Dear Candidate,

Based upon your PET Index (marks), you are required to **appear for counseling** at the Department of Chemistry for possible provisional admission into M.Sc.(Chemistry) of 2011-12 session, subject to availability of seats, **on 01 Aug, 2011 at 10.30 A.M.** In this connection, it is mandatory on your part to fulfill the following requirements:

1. The candidate must have completed B.Sc.(Hons) / B.Sc. under at least 10+2+3 pattern and fulfill the admission criterion laid down in the PET-2011 booklet.
2. The candidate must produce all the Certificates & Marks sheets (from Class X to B.Sc. level) in **original** at the time of counseling.
3. The candidate must bring **original PET admit card**, two sets of **Xerox copies of all the academic documents and five photographs.**
4. The admitted candidates will be required to deposit approximately the following fees for 1<sup>st</sup> semester: (a) ~Rs. 3,000/- for Day-Scholars and (b) ~Rs. 6,000/- for Hostellers (hostel seats are limited and will be allotted on merit basis)
5. In case of opting for admission under Paid-seat category, the candidate will be required to fill the option form for the same at the time of counseling and those admitted under Paid-seat category will have to pay an additional amount of Rs.30,000/- (Rs. Thirty thousand only) per year.

**Note:** Please bear in mind that the number of eligible candidates called for counseling is much larger than the seats available in the course to which you are seeking admission. Therefore, mere receipt of the Call Letter does not entitle you for provisional admission. The Admission of the eligible candidates shall be made strictly on the basis of merit index of PET-2011 against the available seats. No eligible candidate shall advance any claim, whatsoever, for the provisional admission if seats are not vacant at the time of consideration of his/her candidature for admission
