Dear Candidate,

Based upon your PET Index (marks) as given above, you are required to **appear for counseling** at the Department of Chemistry for possible provisional admission into M.Sc.(Chemistry) of 2010-11 session, subject to availability of seats, **on 18/19-7-2010 at 10.00 A.M.** In this connection, it is mandatory on your part to fulfill the following requirements:

1. The candidate must have completed B.Sc.(Hons) / B.Sc. under at least 10+2+3 pattern securing a minimum of 50% marks in the aggregate in science subjects (considering all the three years of B.Sc. course). The subject, in which admission is sought, must be honours subject at B.Sc. (Hons) level / a subject studied in all the three parts at graduate level.
2. The candidate must produce all the Certificates & Marks sheets (from Class X to B.Sc. level) **in original** at the time of counseling.
3. The candidate must bring **original PET admit card**, two sets of **Xerox copies of all the academic documents and five photographs**.
4. In case of admission, the candidate will be required to deposit approximately the following fees for 1st semester: (a) ~Rs. 2,700/- for Day-Scholars and (b) ~Rs. 6,000/- for Hostellers (hostel seats are limited and will be allotted on merit basis)
5. In case of opting for admission under Paid-seat category, the candidate will be required to fill the option form for the same at the time of counseling and those admitted under Paid-seat category will have to pay an additional amount of Rs.30,000/- (Rs. Thirty thousand only) per year.
