Prof. Singh is the Vice Chancellor of Nava Nalanda Mahavihara University (Deemed University), Ministry of Culture, Government of India. Additionally, he also holds the post of Director In-Charge, Khuda Bakhsh Oriental Public Library, Patna. In a permanent position, he is a Senior Professor in the Department of Pali and Buddhist Studies at Banaras Hindu University (B.H.U.), Varanasi, India. Prof. Siddharth Singh was also a Diplomat and Director of the Indian Cultural Centre, Embassy of India, Tokyo, from 2018 to 2022, where he worked extensively to promote Indian culture in Japan and strengthen the India-Japan soft-diplomatic relationships. He has also been the recipient of the Buddhist Culture Promotion Award, Uttar Pradesh Government (2025); the Fulbright Senior Research Fellowship, USA (2011-2012); the President Award as a young scholar, Government of India (2005); and the Japan Foundation Fellowship, Japan (2003-04).

Dr. Siddharth has been an ICCR Chair Visiting Professor of Indian Studies at Uppsala University, Sweden (2014-2015); Visiting Professor at Karlstad University, Sweden, in the years 2006 and 2008, and Hyderabad Central University during 2011-12. He has published four books and 80 papers in Hindi, English and Japanese encompassing various aspects of Indian Culture and Buddhism and delivered lectures and presented several National and International papers on different occasions in India and countries like the USA, Japan, China, Sweden, Estonia, Thailand, Singapore, Taiwan, Sri Lanka, Myanmar, Vietnam, Nepal, etc.

Dr. Singh's major interests are the applied aspects of Buddhism, Indian culture, world religions and philosophies, Pali and Sanskrit literature, and Japanese culture.
