- Abstract should be unstructured, within single paragraph.
- Font: Times New Roman, Text should be justified (single spacing, margin: L2", R1").
- Title: Capital and bold with font size 14, Author's Name: Bold with font size 12.
- Affliation: Address of institution with e-mail ID of corresponding author only.
- Presenting author should be underlined. Title, Authors' name and Affiliation should be centre aligned.
- Key words: 4-5 words in Italics, bold with font size 10.
- The size of the poster should be 3 ft (W) × 4 ft (H) [Portrait mode]
- Last date for submission of abstracts is 25th October 2025.
