UG SPOT Round Registration & Guidelines

Candidate's interested in applying for admission in the UG Programs of the Banaras Hindu University through the SPOT Round should note the following:

Candidates seeking admission in SPOT Round shall have to first register themselves on the portal by paying the SPOT Registration fee Rs. 1000/-:

Eligibility:

- 1. The following candidates will be eligible to register in the Spot-round:
 - a) Candidates who have not registered for BHU UG Counseling so far.
 - b) Candidates who registered for the BHU UG Counseling process but
 - i) were not offered any seat during the regular round allotment (waitlisted).
 - ii) were offered seats but could not deposit the fee in stipulated time.
 - iii) deposited the admission fee but got their admissions cancelled or withdrawal, rejected during verification.
- 2. The following candidates will not be eligible for SPOT Round:
 - a) Candidates who have been admitted in the regular rounds and holding the admission.
 - b) There will be no SPOT Round in courses having practical components i.e. BPA & BFA.
- 3. The vacant seat status for the Spot Round is announced on 02.09.2025, the online portal is frozen for already admitted students. They cannot withdraw / cancel their existing admissions during SPOT round registration.
- 4. Spot Round seat allotment will be based on the following factors:
 - a) Availability of seats in the chosen program.
 - b) Candidate's merit ranking for that specific program.
 - c) Order of preference for Faculties/colleges (if applicable).
 - d) Candidate's category (e.g., Unreserved, OBC-NCL, SC, ST, etc.).
- 5. Candidates willing to participate in the SPOT round are advised to ensure themselves regarding the number of seats available in different programs and categories on the counseling portal before registration which is available on the admission tab of BHU website.
- 6. Preferences are editable for already registered candidates.
- 7. Visit https://bhu.ac.in for "UG Spot Round Vacant Seat Status"
- 8. Seats will be allotted according to the merit and other prevailing rules of the University/GoI against the vacancies shown on the portal for the SPOT round.
- 9. Cut off of the spot round will be incomparable from the regular rounds.
