The 4th Round Allotment for the PG programs is LIVE. The last date for fee payment is **Aug 04, 2025 (23:59)**.

At the time of reporting, Candidates will be required to produce the following original documents along with one set of its photocopy and six passport size photographs (as listed in the CAP PG – 2025).

1. High School, Intermediate, U.G. Mark sheets and Certificates;
2. Category Certificate (OBC-NCL/EWS/SC/ST/PwBD/Ward whichever applicable);
3. Original copy of Transfer Certificate, Migration Certificate and Character Certificate;
4. Undertaking for non-involvement in Ragging by the student and their parents/guardians (available at www.bhu.ac.in);
5. Filled Residence/Dossier form (in triplicate), (available at www.bhu.ac.in);
6. BHU Registration Form having the preference order;
7. CUET NTA Application Form and CUET NTA Score card.

In case a candidate fails to produce a valid Category Certificate (as claimed for the admission) his/ her candidature shall be summarily cancelled without any further notice. The EWS certificate should be issued on or after April 01, 2024; OBC Certificate should be issued on or after Jan 01, 2025.

However, if the candidate fails to produce documents listed at points 1 and 3, an extension (not beyond Oct 31, 2025) may be permitted on request.

On the date of reporting, all the PwBD candidates will be examined by a Medical Board constituted by BHU, as per criteria fixed by the University. The decision of the Medical Board constituted by BHU will be final.
