

## Achievements of the Session 2020-21

1.The result of CBSE Board Examination- 2020 of Class-X was100 %. A total of 277 students appeared in the Board Examination. Mayank Kushwaha became the School Topper by scoring 99% marks. Jayesh Bhardwaj got Second place in the school by scoring 98.40 % marks.

Ravi Ranjan Kumar secured Third position by getting 98.40 % marks. A total of 19 students of the School secured 100% marks in different subjects and were awarded Certificate of Merit by CBSE under 0.1 Merit Category of CBSE Exam-2020.The names of students are:

2. In the Board Examination of Class X, a total of 108 students in English, 84 students in Hindi, 116 students in Mathematics, 76 students in Science and 175 students in Social Science scored above 90% marks.

3. The result of CBSE Examination- 2020 of Class- XII was 98.04%. A total of 418 students appeared in the Board Examination. Sandeep Kushwaha (Arts Stream) became the School topper by securing 97.40% marks. Shashank Kumar (Science Group) got Second place by securing 96.60 % and Nawal preet Singh (Commerce stream) secured Third position by scoring 95.20% marks.

4. The number of students appeared in School Home Examination of Class VI, VII, VIII, IX and XI was 1285. Hari Om Kumar (Class VIII) became the School Topper by securing 98.42 % marks. Arpit Kumar Verma, Kamalkant Singh, Ayush Kumar of class IX and Hari Om Kumar of class VIII secured 100% marks in Mathematics. Class wise name of toppers is given below: VI – Shivam Yadav (VI-B) -92.92% VII – Kumar Divyansh (VII- B) - 93.14% VIII – Hari Om (VIII-C) – 98.42% IX- (i) Adarsh Singh (IX-F) - 96.16% (ii) Aryan Maurya (IX-B) – 96.16% XI (Math)- Raman Sharma – 93.80% XI (Bio Group)-Abhishek Singh (XI B2) – 90.00% XI (Commerce)-Vishwas Giri (XI-E) – 92.83% XI (Arts)-Rakshit Sinha (XI-F) – 94.50%

5. Six Students of the School (Dilip Kumar, Vaibhav Vishwakarma, Aditya Singh, Amit Kumar, Harsh Jaiswal and Abhishek Kumar) got selected with good merit in the prestigious exam of JEE-2020. Sachin Prasad Gaund and Shivam Kumar qualified in Medical Entrance Examination- NEET.

6. Students of the school from class VI to X participated in Online Mental Ability Recognition Test organized by Unified Council, Hyderabad. Ashutosh Kumar Patel (class VI) got First position in the school and got 352nd rank at all India level. Abhishek Tripathi (Class VIII) and Prabhat Kumar (IX) secured first place in their respective classes. Four students of the school secured places in the Merit List in Unified International Math Olympiad-2021.

7. A total of 47 students secured places in the Merit List of National Talent Search Examination organized by Society for Social Action and Research (SAAR) conducted in online mode. Raghvendra Rai (class XII), Aditya Bhardwaj (class IX) and Anand Kumar (class VII) got First position at district level. Saksham Yadav (class VIII), Naveen Kumar and Gaurav Kumar Modanwal of class IX and Saurabh Singh (class XI) got First places in their respective classes.

8. Anurag Varshney (class XI-Arts) secured 11th place at all India level in online GK competition, Mind War Olympiad -2020: Champions of Tomorrow. He was awarded with a Cash Prize of Rs.11000/-.

9. Alumni of the school, Siddharth Pathak, obtaining 9th rank in UPPCS Exam-2019 and Ankit Mishra, having got selected for the post of Deputy S.P. in the same exam earned immense pride for their alma mater. Another alumnus, Sumit Pandey, got 607th rank in UPSC Civil Services Exam.

## **Other Achievements and Co-curricular Activities**

1. Apart from conducting academic and cultural activities the school also celebrates the birth anniversaries of great and noble persons with full enthusiasm and grandeur in which the entire school family actively takes part. This year, on the occasion of Shankaracharya Jayanti on 29.04.2020, an online Stotra Patha Pratiyogita was organized under the guidance of Dr. Anupam Kumar Tiwari (PGT- Sanskrit).
