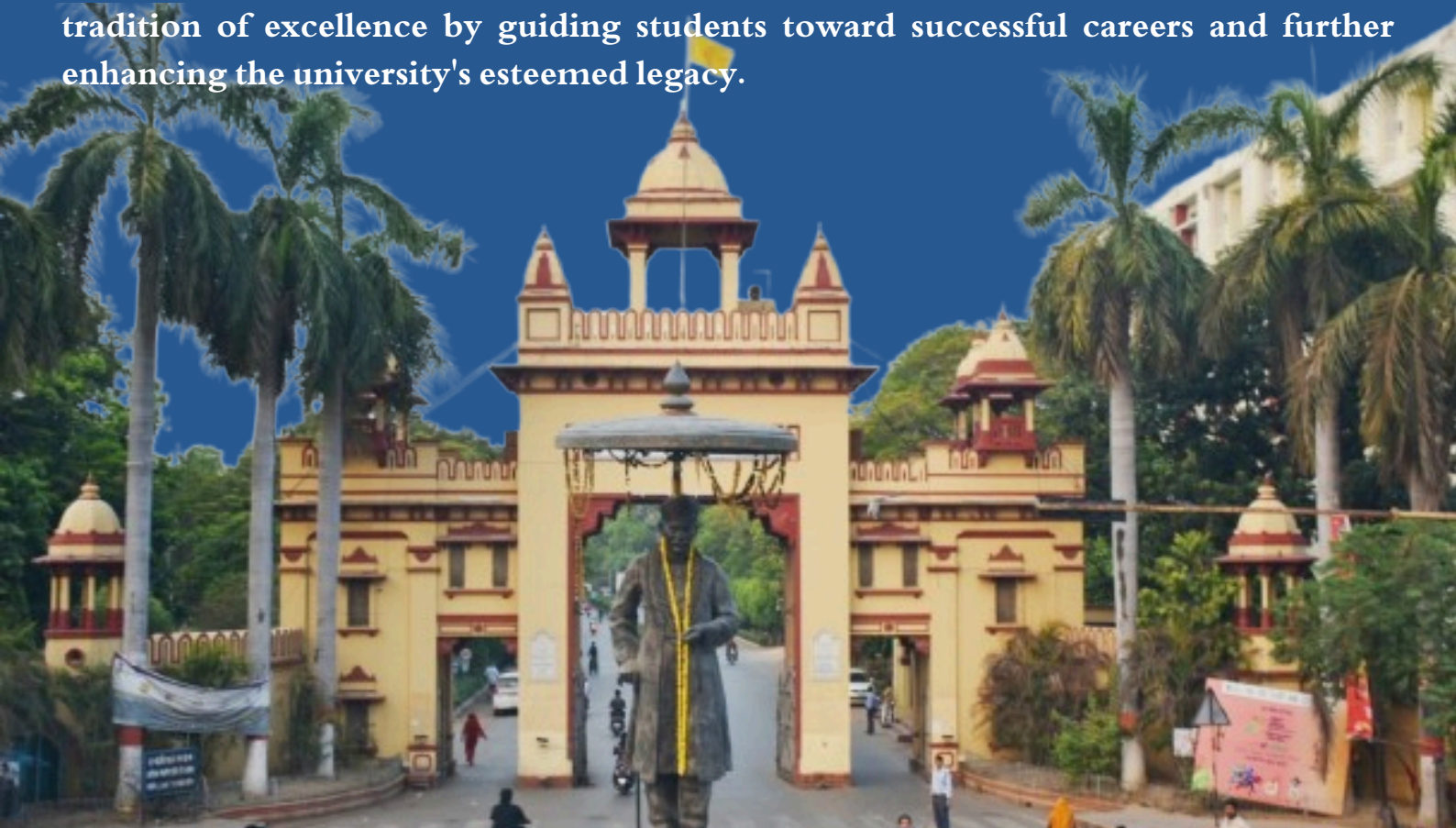

PRO-BONO CLUB

The Faculty has a Pro Bono Club in collaboration with Nyaya-Bandhu (Pro-Bono Legal Services), an initiative of the Department of Justice, Ministry of Law and Justice. The club's vision to create a legally empowered society where justice is accessible to all, and law students play an active role in bridging the gap between legal rights and reality. The Pro Bono Club, Faculty of Law, BHU, envisions a society where justice is accessible to all, regardless of socio-economic status. It aims to empower marginalized communities by providing free legal aid, spreading legal awareness, and nurturing a culture of social responsibility among law students. The club comprises of 10 members from all the courses under the guidance Dr. Dolly Singh. The club is actively working for the marginalized sections of society and currently has organised various awareness programmes in various schools of Varanasi and has adopted a village Ramana to work on the initiative of 'Mukadma Vihin Gaon'.

LEGAL AID CELL

The Legal Aid and Service Clinic is a constituent unit of the Faculty of Law, Banaras Hindu University. This clinic has been serving the society since the year 1977. Its objective is to achieve our constitutional goals as enshrined under the Preamble of the Indian Constitution. The clinic works to make legal aid available to poor and marginalised people in India.

VIDHI VICHAR SABHA

The "Vidhi Vichar Sabha" at the Faculty of Law, Banaras Hindu University, is the official student debating and oratorical society, fostering critical thinking and public speaking. MOOT COURT COMMITTEE

The Moot Court Committee (MCC) is an official committee responsible for regulating mooting and other allied activities at the Faculty of Law, BHU. In the realm of legal education, where the seeds of justice are sown, MCC is a student-run body that functions under the able guidance and supervision of Dr. K.N. Sharma. The MCC consists of appointed student representatives from the courses of LL.B. (Hons.) and B.A. LL.B. (Hons.). MCC is headed by a Student Coordinator and two Joint Coordinators. The committee annually conducts an Intra-Moot Court Competition, which serves as the basis for selecting students to represent the University in both National and International competitions. Apart from maintaining a strong internal mooting structure, the committee annually hosts its flagship event, the Mahamana Malaviya National Moot Court Competition.

NOTABLE EVENTS OF SESSION 2024–25 & 2025–26

CENTENNIAL NATIONAL CONFERENCE

The National Conference on Legal Education, held at the Faculty of Law, Banaras Hindu University, on February, 2024, was a landmark event that brought together legal scholars, educators, practitioners, and administrators from across the country. This two-day conference celebrated a century of legal education at BHU and provided a platform to critically assess the current state of legal education and its future direction. Guided by the ancient wisdom of the Chandogya Upanishad, which teaches that “knowledge is one that liberates,” the conference aimed to explore how legal education can be reformed to better serve societal needs and advance justice.

INTERNATIONAL SEMINAR

In an increasingly globalized world, international institutions play a pivotal role in addressing global challenges. The conference provided an in-depth exploration of how these institutions tackle critical issues such as the COVID-19 pandemic, climate change, and ongoing conflicts, including the Israel-Palestine and Russia-Ukraine disputes. This conference focused on evaluating the effectiveness and efficiency of international institutions in resolving crises and fulfilling their objectives. It offered a platform to discuss the challenges faced by these institutions and assess their performance in achieving meaningful outcomes.

SPANDAN

Spandan is the annual inter-faculty youth cultural festival of Banaras Hindu University, with a long-standing tradition of showcasing student talent across music, dance, drama, and literature. Though its exact inception date is not clearly documented, it remains a major cultural event, reflecting creativity, competition, and camaraderie among students.

WORKSHOP ON NEW CRIMINAL LAWS

The Institute of Constitutional and Parliamentary Studies (ICPS), in collaboration with the Faculty of Law, Banaras Hindu University (BHU), organized a one-day workshop on new criminal laws on 21st September 2024 at the Faculty of Law, BHU. The workshop focused on three new laws: the Bharatiya Nagrik Suraksha Sanhita, Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, and Bharatiya Sakshya Adhinyam, which replace the colonial-era IPC, CrPC, and Evidence Act. This workshop aimed to enlighten the students, faculty members and law enforcement officers about the latest developments in the new criminal laws and their future implications.

KASHI NYAYA SAMAGAM ON BHARATIYA JURISPRUDENCE

The Kashi Nyaya Samagam on Bharatiya Jurisprudence was a significant event that focused on exploring and discussing the principles and impact of Indian legal philosophy and current legal system. The event aimed to delve into the rich traditions of Indian jurisprudence and its relevance in contemporary legal systems. The conference typically featured a range of activities, including keynote addresses, panel discussions, and scholarly presentations, all centered around the themes of traditional Indian legal texts, legal theory, and the integration of ancient legal principles with modern legal practices.

INAUGURATION OF PRO-BONO CLUB

The Faculty of Law, Banaras Hindu University (BHU) witnessed a momentous occasion with the inauguration of its Pro Bono Club on February 8, 2025, a pioneering initiative dedicated to legal assistance and social justice. Held at the Faculty Lounge, the event brought together eminent legal luminaries, academicians, and students in a shared commitment to access to justice. Shri Vijay Kumar Vishwakarma (Add. District & Sessions Judge, Varanasi and Secretary, DLSA), and Shri Arvind Kumar Mishra (District & Sessions Judge, Mirzapur). Discussions encompassed legal aid clinics, para-legal volunteers, and challenges faced during legal aid. An interactive session with students enriched the discourse, reinforcing their role in bridging legal knowledge and community service. This inauguration marked a transformative step in BHU Law School's legacy, reaffirming its commitment to justice, service, and legal empowerment.

WORKSHOP ON CONTEMPORARY CHALLENGES IN INDIAN TAXATION

The National Workshop on Contemporary Challenges in Indian Taxation was a significant event held in the Faculty of Law. There were eminent officers including Additional Commissioner of Income Tax, Joint Commissioner of Income Tax (Indian Revenue Services), professors from prestigious institutions, invited to give lectures on topics that were of paramount importance, such as "the inclusion of AI in combating tax evasion", "way forward for India to become tax advanced country", etc. The event gathered a huge crowd of students as well as scholars from the faculty and it was concluded harmoniously.

Moot Court Competitions

11th Mahamana Malviya National Moot Court Competiton

The 11th Mahamana Malaviya National Moot Court Competition 2024, a premier annual event organized by the Faculty of Law, BHU, was held with great success by the Moot Court Committee (MCC). The competition took place in collaboration with Competition Commission of India and Cyril Amarchand Mangaldas. This prestigious competition saw participation from over 60 teams across the country, with more than 20 teams advancing to the oral rounds to demonstrate their legal expertise and advocacy skills.

The 12th edition of our National Moot Court Competiton, 2025, was a successful event orgaised by the Moot Court Committee(MCC), Faculty of Law, BHU, The Competition was held in collaboration with SCC Online. The event witnessed a participation of more than 90 teams with only 20 team from different states advancing to oral rounds. The event was blessed with the presence of dignitaries like Hon'ble Justice J.J. Munir (Delhi High Court), Hon'ble Justice Siddharth (Allahabad High Court), Hon'ble Justice Dharindar Jha (Former Judge Patna High Court), Mr. S.V. 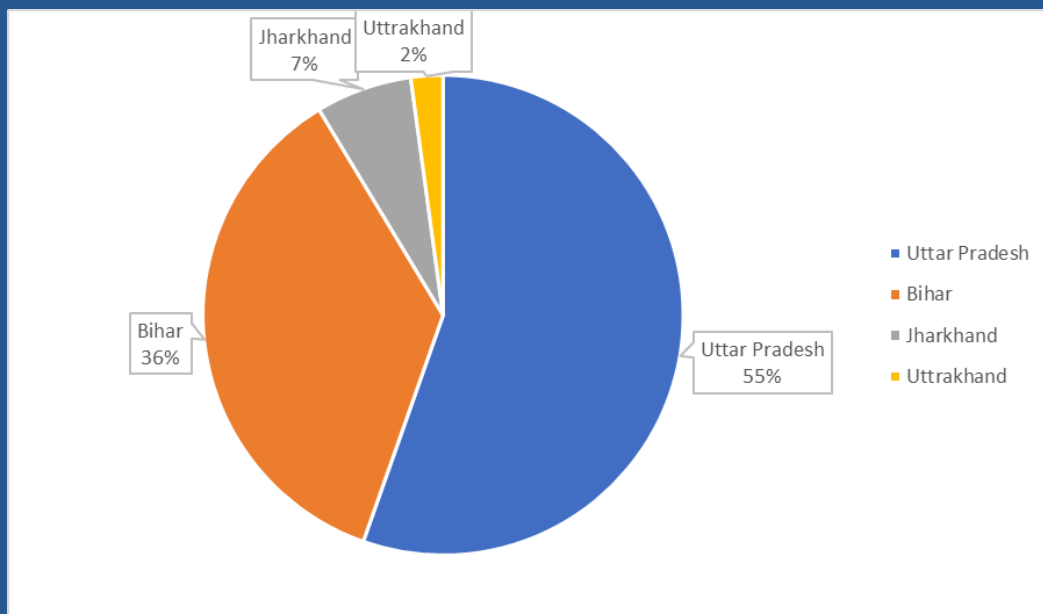

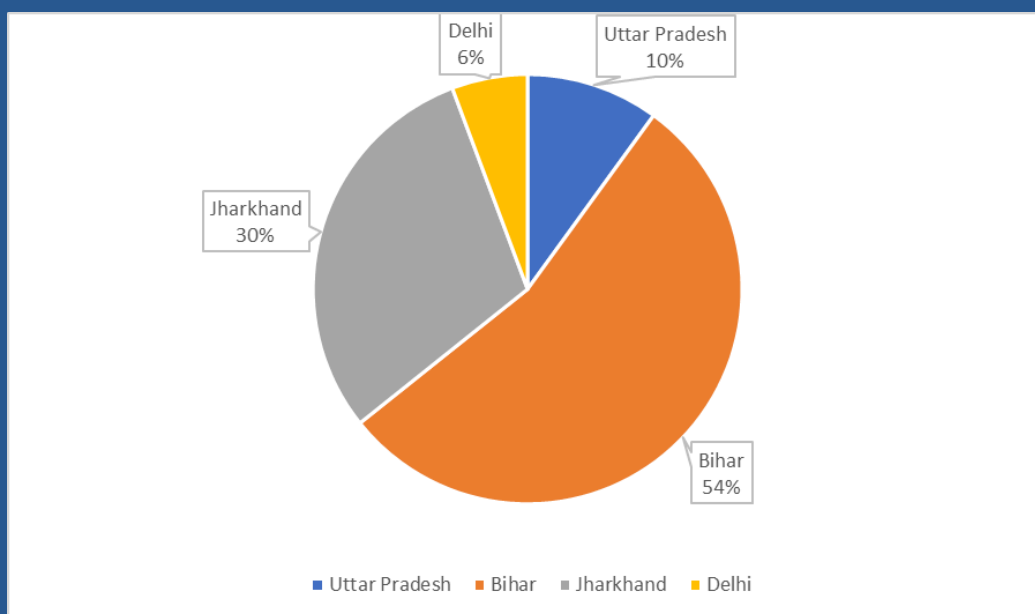

ACHIEVEMENTS IN JUDICIARY IN LAST FIVE YEARS

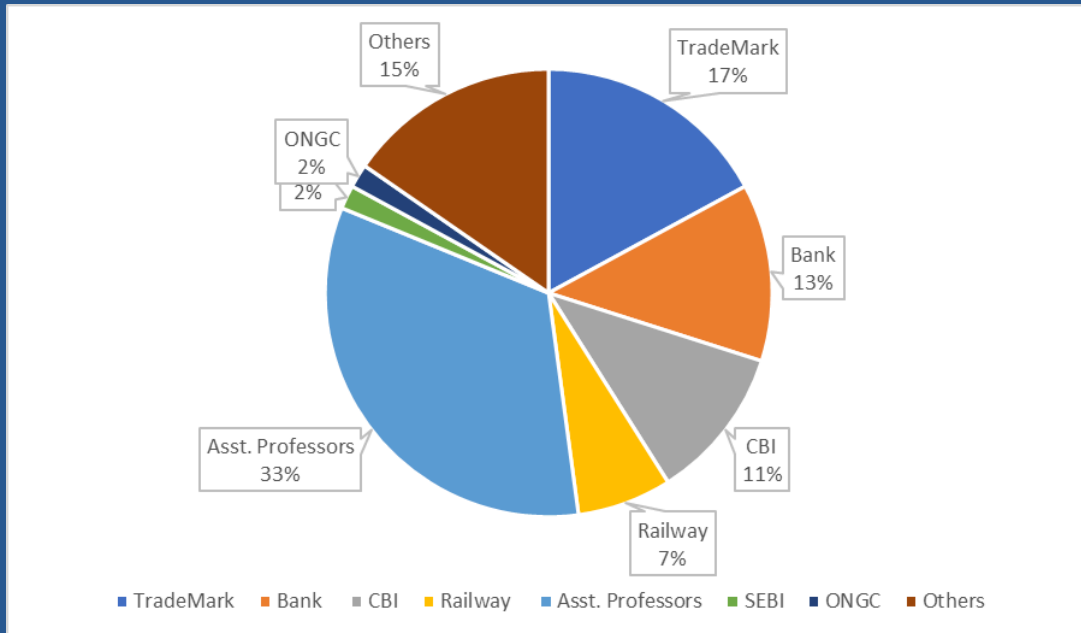


ACHIEVEMENTS IN ASSISTANT PROSECUTION OFFICERS

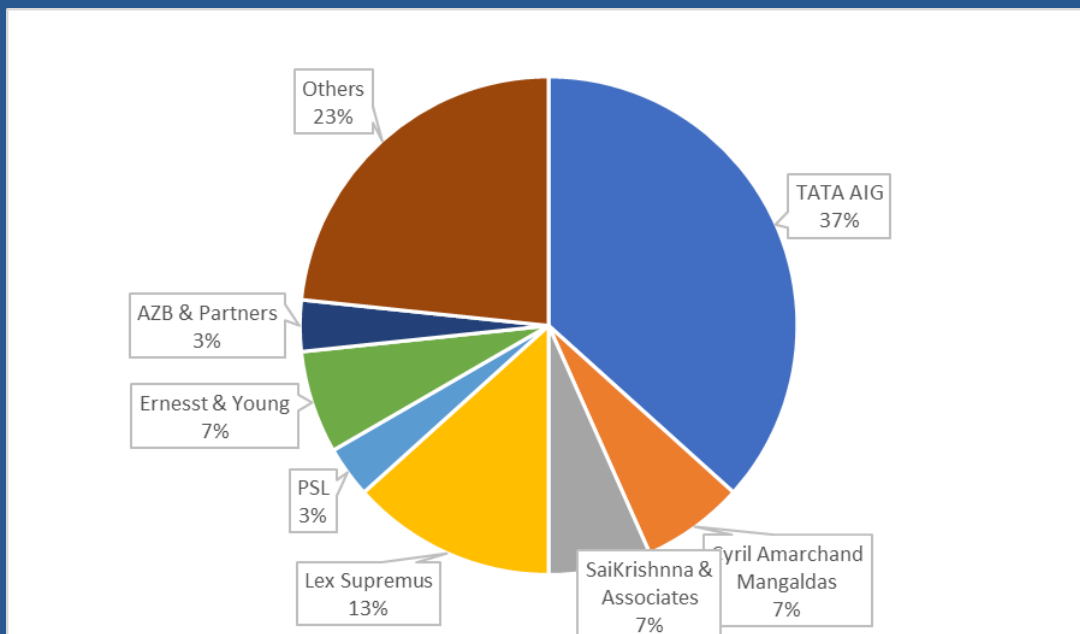
