 - e. Transfer & Migration Certificate from the last attended institution
 - f. Admit Card which was issued by B.Sc Nursing/B.Pharm (Ay.)/BOT/BPT-2019, in original.
 - g. Caste certificate, in original for the students of SC/ST, OBC (Non Creamy layer) categories (Central Govt.) issued within 6 months from the competent authority with eligibility criteria of reservation.
