29. In case of any inadvertent mistake in the process of selection which may be detected at any stage even after the issue of appointment letter, the University reserves right to modify/withdraw/cancel any communication made to the candidate.
30. In case of any dispute/ambiguity that may occur in the process of selection, the decision of the University shall be final.
31. Applicants who are in employment should route their application through proper channel or should submit a "No Objection Certificate" from the employer prior to the interview, failing which they may not be considered further.
32. Canvassing in any form will be a disqualification.
33. No interim correspondence shall be entertained.
34. On the positions reserved for specially abled persons (OH, VI, HH), all categories of specially abled persons are requested to apply since if the designated category of specially abled person is not available, the post may be filled with other categories of specially abled suitable and eligible candidates applied and available.
